The following methods, of casting a ballot, are available to all DeKalb County Voters:

Vote by Mail: Applications Now Available  
Early Voting: February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021  
(in Sycamore)  
Grace Period Voting: March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021  
Satellite Early Voting: March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021  
Election Day Voting: April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Any registered voter who is physically incapable of going to the polls on Election Day may apply to the County Clerk for a ballot to be voted at home. The vote may be cast by either the Vote by Mail or Disabled Voter Programs. An individual admitted to a hospital, nursing home or rehabilitation center, within 14 days of the election, is eligible for the Hospitalized Voter Program. Pre-arranged Curbside Voting is also available. Please call the DeKalb County Elections' Office at 815-895-7147 for enrollment information.
