**PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE TAX
EXTENSION LIMITATION**

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Maple Park & Countryside Fire Protection District, DeKalb and Kane Counties, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 31.76% above the limiting rate for the 2019 levy year for the purpose of staffing, equipment and facilities and be equal to .72747% of the equalized assessed valuation of the taxable property therein for the 2021 levy year?

(1) The amount of taxes extended at the most recent limiting rate would be \$472,320. The amount of taxes that would be extended if this referendum passes would be \$622,320.

(2) If the proposition were to pass, the owner of a single-family home with a fair cash market value of \$100,000.00 at the time of the referendum would pay \$58.45 in additional taxes.

(3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2021 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
